

TACCM.org serves as TACCM's public website as well as the organization's members-only portal. The website features a membership directory, event calendar, and online event registration system.



### Membership Directory

TACCM's online membership directory allows members to locate and contact other members. This feature is only available to members, so your personal information is only made available to other TACCM members. The membership directory displays "business cards," including each member's name, email address, phone numbers, and a photo (if provided).

### How to Update Your Member Profile

You can update your Member Profile, which includes your personal information, member preferences, biography, and a photo. To access your Member Profile:

1. Click the MEMBER LOGIN link near the top of the screen and log in using your username and password.
2. Hover over your name and select PROFILE from the drop-down menu.
3. Update your BIOGRAPHY so that other members can get to know you better.
4. Upload a photo so that other members can put a face to your name. Click BROWSE, select the JPEG or GIF file from your computer, AND then click UPLOAD PHOTO. (We recommend that the photo be no more than 80x80 pixels.)
5. Click SAVE.

## Institutional Memberships

This membership type allows your college to pay one flat rate (\$350) for an unlimited amount of members for your institution. You can also use Perkins Basic funding from your campus to pay for this membership type. NOTE: A college must apply for a separate institutional membership if it is a campus with a separate president and a separate name.

Follow these directions to add members to an Institutional Membership:

### How to Add or Remove Members to/from Your Institutional Membership

If you are the primary member for an Institutional Membership, you can add, remove, or edit organizational members. Once you have added members, they will be able to log in separately and edit their own profiles.

1. Click the MEMBER LOGIN link near the top of the screen and log in using your username and password.
2. Hover over your name and select PROFILE from the drop-down menu.
3. On the PROFILE page, in the PERSONAL INFO block, select ADDITIONAL MEMBERS IN YOUR ACCOUNT.
4. Choose ADD to add organizational members and input basic information for the member being added.
5. Click SAVE.
6. Repeat until all colleagues are entered. (You can also EDIT or REMOVE organizational members.)
7. Click DONE.
